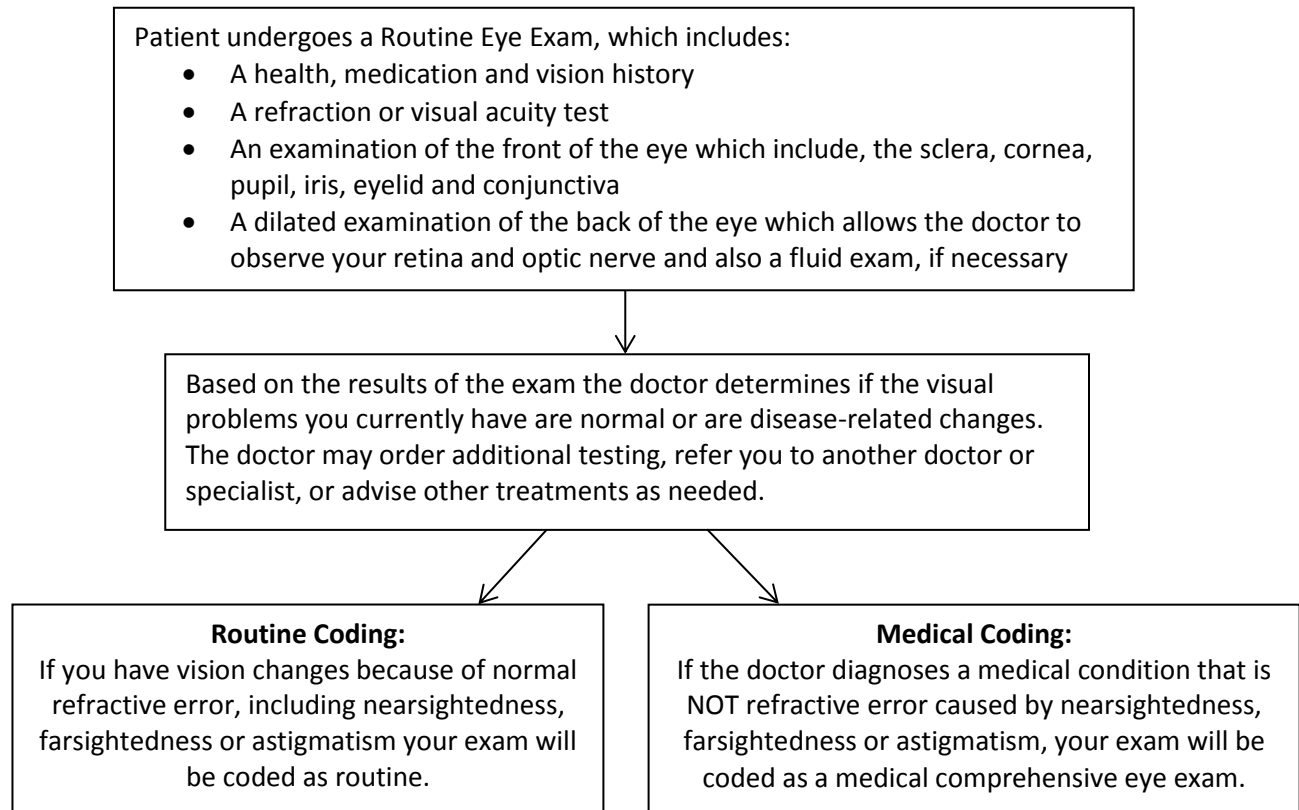




Important Information on the Coding and Billing of your Routine Comprehensive Eye Exam

Even though you have come in today for a Routine Eye Exam, if something medical is discovered and/or addressed in your routine eye exam, the exam may turn into a medical visit and thus be coded differently. Below is how a typical Routine Eye Exam works and is eventually coded:



Once the visit is coded, your insurance company will then use those codes to determine how the visit will be processed (with or without a copay, deductible, coinsurance etc).
